

KBRC 300m Fly Shoot Competition Rules

In order for KBRC to give every shooter a fair chance during any competition hosted at the Krokodilspruit Shooting Range and/or at any of its affiliated clubs, the following rules will be in effect and applicable to all shooters participating in the competition.

1. Each competitor will shoot at two targets in different relays.
2. Only members who have paid their membership fees, entry fees will be allowed to participate. Once-off competitors or guests must complete the entry form on our website www.kbrc.co.za and make payment prior to competition.
3. A sighter target will be provided below the scoring target. Shooters must use this target to dial their scopes.
4. No live ammunition may be placed in the rifle until the Commence Fire command is given.
5. Relays will be increased to 15 minutes to prevent barrels from overheating. Timing starts at the beginning of the word Commence Fire.
6. Timing ceases at the end of the Cease Fire command.
7. Any shots fired before the Commence Fire or after the Cease Fire command, will result in the shooter being disqualified from the relay and his target will not be eligible for scoring.
8. Both targets will be scored, and the best of the two targets will then be eligible for a "Badge"
Badges are awarded as follows:
One or two flies on the best target = 1 x Black Fly.
Three or Four flies on the best target = 1 x Silver Fly.
Five flies on the best target = 1 x Gold Fly.

All shots to be considered MUST clearly touch any printed line that is part of the Fly.
Silver and gold badges must be confirmed by the scorer and one member of management / Range Officer.

9. It is the responsibility of the shooter who cross-fires to immediately advise the Range Officer of such an event, and then fire the balance of their shots on their own target. A shooter who cross-fires and does not notify the range officer, will have been deemed to have inadvertently cross-fired and shall not be disqualified, but shall be penalised 5 points per shot.

We would like to encourage all shooters to earn Gold Badges because in doing so, you will be the person that everyone refers to as "That guy CAN shoot".
