

BASIC SAFETY GUIDE FOR SHOOTING RANGE

1. Never handle a firearm while the range is open.
2. A safe rifle means, the bolt is removed and no ammunition in the chamber, ramp and/or magazine.
3. Only load a bullet and/or bolt after the Range Officer has given the command to do so.
4. Never point a firearm at any person.
5. Always point muzzle of firearm downrange.
6. Only shoot at targets on provided target frames, no bottles, stones, rocks and/or cans.
7. Always obey the commands of the Range Officer.
8. No spectators allowed on the firing line.
9. Any crossfire and/or grievance to be reported to the Range Officer.
10. Always wear ear and eye protection.
11. No person allowed beyond the firing line without the authorisation of the Range officer.
12. Cease fire means – no firing after the cease fire command. If you still have a loaded round in your firearm you must inform the Range Officer in order for him to safely make the firearm safe.
13. Respect the shooting range, please dispose of any spent cases, used targets, tape, etc. in the provided trash bins.
